## Transfer from the airport:

*We try to organize a group transfer from Barcelona Airport to Tarragona BASF, but this depends from your arrival times.*

If you come alone, here your possibilities:

Between Terminal 1 and 2 there is a Shuttle-Bus (green),.

### 1) by Bus

The buses of the Company Plana, Departure from Busstation closed to Terminal 1 see the link. Departure times 9.15; 10.15; 11.30; 12.45; 14.00; time needed to Tarragona:1.05 h; price 13 Euro

This bus goes directly to Tarragona Busstation. There you need to take a taxi to BASF(<10 min)

### 2) by Train

From Terminal 2 there is a Shuttle-train to the station Barcelona Sants. In both terminals you can take also the Metro L9 to the station Barcelona Sants. The trip to Tarragona lasts 0,5 to 1,5 Stunden, depending of the typ of train.

The AVE (Typ ICE) needs reservation.
